

PIM 5-1

Policy for formation of a 2nd comp team within a single gender/age group

1. The current (or “first”) comp coach for each gender/age group will serve as “age group coordinator”, and original comp team will be considered the “A” team.
2. Conditions to be met for the future formations of 2nd, or “B” teams include
A) Approval of the age group coordinator, B) Designation of “traveling rec team”, C) Minimum roster of 10, D) Combined practices of “A” & “B” teams, E) All final decisions for both teams are to be made by age group coordinator.
3. “B” teams are only permitted up until U12, when “B” team will be dissolved or combined with “A” team.
4. Try-outs will not be held for the “B” teams, but instead will be held for A teams with highest-level players going to the “A” team, and players needing more development going to “B” team.
5. All other Rules & Regulations, Policies, and Bylaws requirements must also be met.

PIM 5-2

Policy for % of true age players on Class I and Class III team rosters

1. All Class I and Class III teams should have a minimum of 70% of the roster filled with true age players.
2. With board approval a team may have as low as 50% true age players on their roster.
3. All active team rosters as of May 2011 will be considered “grandfathered” with no roster adjustments required.
